

Community Updates As is our tradition, we will not conduct any business at the Decembe meeting (holiday party) so here are a few brief updates for your review. 100 Steps

Ravine Road/New York Avenue

NJ Dept of Transportation grant it received (an extension to this date was granted but no further extensions will be given). Rosemary McFadden, Chief of Staff to Mayor Healy, assured us in a telephone conversation on Dec 4th that the city will award the contract at the Dec. 19th council meeting. We will remain vigilant as the construction of the Steps is important to our neighborhood and was a condition of approval for The Cliffs apartments.

The city received viable bids and needs to award the contract at the December 19th city council meeting or lose the \$300,000

- A contract has been awarded (\$1 million+ funded with a NJ DOT grant) by the city to AJM for the renovation of Ravine Road. RNA attended the pre-construction meeting and learned that construction is expected to begin in March 2013 and continue for 9 months. Ravine Road is expected to be closed during this entire time. Gazebo/Sandy damage
- We have been told by the City that replacing the gazebo will be part of Jersey City's FEMA request for funding. We are trying to find out a) the level of funding - does it cover the entire cost or a percentage b) the timing of the funding. RNA has tentatively scheduled a benefit on February 1 at the Landmark Loew's Theatre to raise money toward replacing the gazebo and the trees that were felled. Details will follow.
